A Dream... A Decision... and one powerful WOW!

Willow walked into our Center carrying more than the possibility of a pregnancy—she was carrying the weight of a dream she had worked toward since she was a little girl. At 24, she had just completed her Bachelor’s degree and been accepted into a prestigious graduate program she once believed was only possible in her imagination. It felt rare. Sacred. Once in a lifetime.

“If I’m pregnant, I won’t have a choice,” Willow told her Patient Advocate quietly, almost as if asking for agreement. “I can’t throw this opportunity away.”

But as soon as she said it, anxiety overtook her. Tears filled her eyes. Through them she admitted she was a Christian and believed all life is created in the image of God. Saying the word abortion felt like it split her heart in two. She tried to convince herself she was simply late because of stress and excitement. Yet you could see the wrestling in her spirit.

The pregnancy test was positive.

Our team prayed with her and gently talked through her fears. Then came the ultrasound. On the screen appeared one of the clearest, most active eight-week babies either of our staff had ever seen. Willow stared as the tiny life moved. Tears streamed down her face.

“Wow,” she whispered.

Afterward, she shared the battle between her heart and her ambition. Our licensed medical professional talked with her about deferring enrollment and the many ways women continue their education while pregnant or parenting. Dreams don’t have to die—they may simply take a different path.

A week later she returned—calmer. The baby had grown, still active. This time she smiled.

“I guess I’m going to have a baby and follow my dreams.”
