“Jordan” came to Community Pregnancy Center convinced that if she was pregnant, abortion would be her choice. She shared that she was single, living with her parents, and had experienced multiple abortions in the past. She felt certain she did not want to continue another pregnancy. She expressed deep resentment toward the father of the baby and initially planned not to tell him about the pregnancy at all.

During the first part of her appointment, Jordan showed very mixed emotions. Although she spoke firmly about abortion, it was clear she was carrying hurt, fear, and uncertainty beneath the surface. Then came the ultrasound.

As the image of her active baby appeared on the screen, everything began to change. Jordan smiled, laughed, and suddenly found herself crying tears of joy as she watched her baby move. In that moment, she no longer felt like abortion was her only option, but still wasn't sure about becoming a parent, especially with how she felt about the father of the baby.

Our Licensed Medical Staff and Patient Advocate encouraged Jordan to speak with the father of the baby and scheduled a follow-up ultrasound for the next week. At that appointment, she shared that she had talked with him about the pregnancy. He admitted he was unsure about becoming a father and initially believed abortion was probably the best option. But, she said as they continued talking, she had started to realize she was beginning to open her heart to the possibility of parenting.

By the second follow-up ultrasound, her decision was clear. Jordan confidently shared that she had chosen to parent... she was going to be a mom! She also shared that the father of the baby had experienced a change of heart as well. Instead of fear and uncertainty, he was now supportive of her decision and was even disappointed he could not attend the ultrasound appointment to see their baby. She had told her parents as well, and they were excited about the pregnancy. As she watched her healthy, growing baby on the screen, she once again cried tears of joy.

Over the past 18 month, the Leadership Team at the Community Pregnancy Center has focused on ensuring our pregnancy related services are of the highest quality service and designed to provide professional, relevant care to the women we serve, especially those who feel ending their pregnancy is their best or only option. This journey has brought changes to our process that ensure we are best serving Gen Z and Generation Alpha - from how we market, our screening process, and the flow of our appointments and follow up.

As a result of the positive impacts of these changes, CPC has been recognized as a "Center of Distinction" by the SperaVita Institute. SperaVita provides training, resources and support to pregnancy centers based on a data driven, linear model of care. In total, more than 125 centers have been trained representing five nations, including 37 US States. Of these centers, fewer than 30 have received the Center of Distinction designation.

The team at CPC wants you to know this wouldn't have been possible without the prayers and support you have provided.
