Her Choice... His Plan! *Alyssa's Story*



When Alyssa, 24, first reached out this past fall, she was overwhelmed, unsure, and open to many options. This was her first pregnancy, and she described herself as “freaked out” and uncertain what to do. She shared that the baby’s father had a good job, wanted to be a dad, and would support her—but ultimately left the decision to her. Alyssa also carried a deep concern

about how her parents, and especially her grandmother—would react to her pregnancy. Her grandmother was the one who took her to church as a child and she was afraid this would damage their close relationship.

During her appointment, Alyssa shared that being pregnant right now was not what she had planned, and a baby would keep her from being able to pursue her plans. She also shared that she knew Jesus but felt distant from church. She welcomed a brief moment of prayer and encouragement to trust God and not walk through this alone.

At her ultrasound, Alyssa was quiet and emotionless. Then came a surprise—she was further along than expected. On the screen was a healthy, active 12-week baby, moving constantly. Afterward, she admitted she felt conflicted. She left still thinking abortion was an option for her.

She did not show for her follow up appointment, nor did she answer our follow up attempts. We didn't hear from Alyssa for a while. Then, after a couple months, she reached out to us. "I'm still pregnant," she said. "I want to parent." She said her parents and grandmother were shocked to hear the news, but have been supporting and encouraging during her pregnancy. Her grandmother has even decided she wants to be called "Nana-G!"

She shared that the care and encouragement she received at her appointment is really what made her change her mind. Then she asked for prenatal care referrals and has since been invited to participate in our Birth Class as she prepares for her baby's arrival in just over a month.

Because of you, Alyssa encountered compassion, truth, and hope in a moment of uncertainty—and chose life.
