




Dear Friends and Partners in Life,



## Surrounded by Courage, Support, & Hope!



When Bella, 16, and Steven, 17, first walked through our doors, they were overwhelmed by fear. Friends had convinced them that abortion was their only option—that they were just kids themselves, incapable of being parents, and destined to lose any chance at a future. Their greatest fear, however, was telling their parents and facing possible anger and disappointment.

This was the first relationship for both of them, and they vulnerably shared that they had little understanding of their bodies, reproduction, or how easily pregnancy can occur. During their first ultrasound, they couldn't take their eyes off the screen. Still, when they left that appointment, fear lingered, and abortion remained on their minds.

When Bella and Steven returned for a second ultrasound, something had changed. They shared that they had spoken with Steven's parents and were surprised by their response. Though his parents were not pleased that the situation had happened, they responded with love and pledged their support. Bella was still terrified to tell her parents. We offered prayer - they accepted. Our Advocate helped them think through that difficult conversation. With Steven's parents offering to stand beside them, Bella and Steven took their next steps forward—not alone, but surrounded by courage, support, and hope.
