When "Alexa" first came through our doors in April, she believed abortion was her only option.

"Alexa" was just six weeks pregnant and overwhelmed by the circumstances surrounding her pregnancy. Her relationship with the father of the baby was unhealthy, and with a history of previous abortions, she felt trapped in a cycle she didn't know how to break. Although she had grown up in a Christian home, she had drifted away from her faith and wasn't sure where to turn.

During her first appointment, she found something she hadn't expected, a safe place to share her fears. She openly talked with one of our advocates, who listened with compassion, answered her questions, and gently reminded her that she wasn't alone.

Then came the ultrasound.

As the image of her tiny six-week-old baby appeared on the screen, her emotions began to surface. She laughed. She cried. Then, with genuine concern, she asked, "Does my baby look okay?"

That simple question revealed that something in her heart was beginning to change.

"Alexa" returned for two more ultrasounds over the following weeks. Each visit gave her another opportunity to see her growing baby, ask questions, and receive encouragement without pressure or judgment. By her third ultrasound, she made the courageous decision to choose life.

Today, "Alexa" is receiving prenatal care and is genuinely excited about her pregnancy. The fear that once defined her has been replaced with hope for the future.

"Alexa's" story is a beautiful reminder that hearts are often changed through relationship, patience, and the opportunity to see the precious life growing within. Thank you for making stories like hers possible. Because of your prayers and faithful support, women facing what feels like an impossible decision can find hope, choose life, and begin a new chapter filled with promise.

Please continue to pray for this mother and her growing baby as they journey forward together.

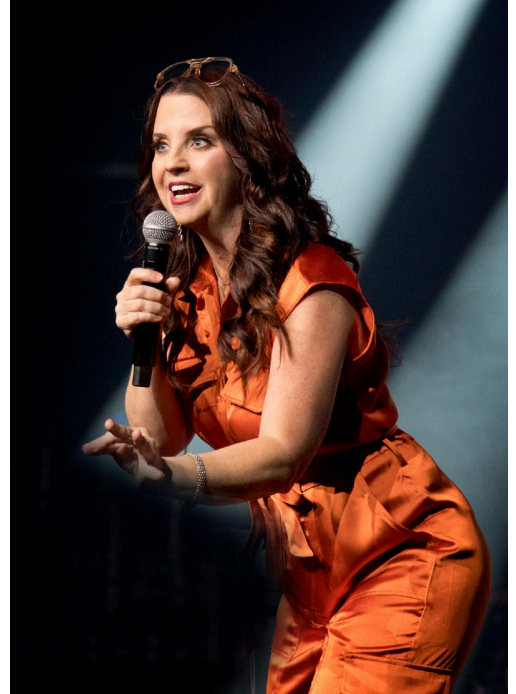
